

U.S. Departure LCL Documentation and Cargo Cut-Offs for Hazardous Cargo

Important Hazardous Information

Listed below, you will find the cut-off times for receipt of LCL Hazardous Materials cargo and documents for <u>all port</u> served by Tropical Shipping:

In addition, due to Port Authority requirements in Barbados that all cargo on a single Bill of Lading must be loaded in the same container, any hazardous cargo to be consolidated on a LCL Bill of Lading will require ALL non-hazardous cargo meet the hazmat cut-off of Noon 2 Days prior to vessel departure.
